Digital-Age Elementary School Activity

Young students from **Fritsch Elementary School** will showcase their digital literacy skills by demonstrating how to create a digital picture story. They will use cameras on their tablets and manage multiple editing applications to customize each picture. In addition, students will highlight how other Web 2.0 tools are integrated into core content subjects.

Digital-Age Middle School Activity

Middle school students and teachers from **Carson City School District** will connect virtually with students in **Clark County School District** to collaborate on a project and display how technology bridges geographic boundaries and creates learning opportunities that would not be possible otherwise.

Digital-Age High School Activities

In partnership with KNPB-Channel 5, students and teachers from **Reno High School** will showcase their Redhouse Project where students generate community awareness by producing public service announcements for local non-profit agencies. Additionally, students will showcase how to use a content management system to create a community events website that will be used for their submission to the Future Business Leaders of America State Competition.

Students and teachers from **Spanish Springs High School** will showcase the C3 Media Academy that trains students in print, web, and video production. Students have access to the latest technology including IMAC computers, iPads, and a full TV studio on campus. This cutting-edge, signature academy gives students real-world experience so they are college and career ready upon graduation. C3 Media Academy students will produce promotional videos of Digital Learning Day and passers-by should not be surprised if they are caught on camera or asked to take part in an interview
